Mr. Lamb called the meeting to order at 8:10 a.m. and gave the opening prayer.

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mr. Leininger to approve the agenda. Motion carried 7-0.

Community Forum: Mrs. Byram expressed thanks from the Cassidy family for the support the school showed at CJ's celebration of life. Mr. Nance shared with Mr. Post about an opportunity for students to attend an MPAA Camp during Farm Fest in October. Mr. Lamb shared that Dr. Sam Alexander contacted him asking for public school support for his campaign.

Consent Agenda: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mrs. Byram to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried 7-0.

Financial Report:

Bills: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mrs. Byram to pay the bills. Motion carried 7-0.

Balance: The balance was reviewed.

Budget: The budget was reviewed and an amended salary schedule was submitted to the board for approval. Mr. Lamb so moved, Mrs. Claflin seconded and the motion carried 7-0.

Facilities: Mr. Post informed the board of the progress that has been made on preparing the school for the new year, since the new custodian was hired. There was discussion of putting more gravel around the bus barn.

Old Business:

CSIP: Mr. Post reviewed CSIP for the board.

New Business:

Local Wellness Policy: Mr. Post submitted the local wellness policy to the board for approval. Mr. Lamb so moved, Mr. Leininger seconded, and the motion carried 7-0.

Meal Prices: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mrs. Byram to set 26-27 meal prices as follows: EL breakfast-\$1.90, HS breakfast-\$2.15, reduced breakfast-\$0.30, adult breakfast-\$2.50, EL lunch-\$2.40, HS lunch-\$2.90, reduced lunch-\$0.40, adult lunch-\$3.90. Motion carried 7-0.

Milk Bids: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mrs. Byram to accept the milk bid from Highland Dairy for the 26-27 school year. Motion carried 7-0.

Fuel Bids: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mr. Lamb to accept the fuel bid from MFA for the 26-27 school year. Motion carried 7-0.

Substitute Teacher Pay: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mr. Lamb to pay substitute teachers \$120 per day for the 26-27 school year. Motion carried 7-0.

Class of 2027 Graduation Date: A motion was made by Mr. Nance and seconded by Mrs. Byram to set the Class of 2027 graduation date for May 16, 2027 with flexibility to change if required. Motion carried 7-0.

Policy & Regulation Updates: A motion was made by Mr. Lamb and seconded by Mrs. Claflin to adopt the changes to Policies 4310, 4320, 4330 and Regulation 4320 with an edit to show Superintendent's discretion for decisions on a case by case basis. Motion carried 7-0.

Set Tax Levy Date: The Tax Levy Hearing was set for August 25, 2026 at 7:00 p.m.

Principal's Report: Mr. Post shared Mrs. McGuirk's and Ms. Young's recent agendas with the board.

Superintendent's Report: Mr. Post gave a legislative update.

Closed Session: At 9:11 a.m. Mr. Nance made a motion to move into closed session after, a short recess, for discussion and possible action regarding 610.021 RSMO for the purpose of (3) Personnel-Hiring/terminating/disciplining/promoting and (13) Personnel-Records/evaluations/applications. Mrs. Byram seconded and the motion carried with the following vote: Mr. Lamb-yes, Mr. Leininger-yes, Mr. Sprenkle-yes, Mr. Nance-yes, Mrs. Leavell-yes, Mrs. Byram-yes, Mrs. Claflin-yes.
